PoleCandy 2017 Rules and Regulations

1. Definitions

- a) Application Form means the document entitled Application Form;
- b) Competition means PoleCandy 2017 to be held at The Metro Theatre on 23 September 2017;
- c) Competitor means the person applying to compete and or competing in the Competition;
- d) Entry Fee is \$20.00AUD.
- e) Entry Period means the period between 12am 2 May 2017 and 12am 2 July 2017;
- f) Organiser means Industry of Movement Pty Ltd ACN 616 451 631; and
- g) Rules means the Rules and Regulations for PoleCandy 2017, including the waiver of liability as set out in Rule 7, being this document.

2. General Eligibility

To be eligible to enter the Competition the Competitor must:

- a) submit an Application;
- b) be at least 18 years old; and
- c) be an Australian Permanent Resident or Australian Citizen.

3. Competition Entry

In order to enter into PoleCandy 2017 a Competitor must submit an Application in accordance with the following:

- a) Applications to enter PoleCandy must be submitted by email to info@suzieqpolestudio.com.au during the Entry Period.
- b) Applications must include:
 - Application Form;
 - Signed and initialled copied of these Rules;
 - A Video Entry;
 - Entry Fee; and
 - 2 recent photos of the Competitor that may be freely used by the Organiser.

4. Entry Fee

5. Video Entry Requirements

- a) The Competitor must only submit one Video Entry.
- b) The Video Entry must not be edited in any way whatsoever.
- c) The Video Entry must not exceed 2:30 minutes.
- d) The Video Entry must be uploaded to YouTube and the link sent to the Organiser.

6. Amateur Solo Division

- a) A Competitor is eligible to enter and compete as an Amateur unless they are eligible to compete as in the Semi-Professional Division or Professional Division.
- b) The Amateur division is ungraded in accordance with the meaning of graded competitions under the National Competition Eligibility Standards.
- c) The Competitor's performance at the Competition must not exceed 2:45 minutes.

7. Semi-Professional Solo Division

- a) A Competitor is eligible to enter and compete as a Semi-Professional in accordance with the National Competition Eligibility Standards.
- b) The Competitor's performance at the Competition must not exceed 3:30 minutes.

8. Professional Eligibility

- a) A competitor is eligible to enter and compete as a Professional in accordance with the National Competition Eligibility Standards.
- b) The Competitor's performance at the Competition must not exceed 4:00 minutes.

9. Competitor Acknowledgements and Warranties

- a) The Competitor warrants that they are skilled in pole dancing and acknowledge that pole dancing is a dangerous recreational activity.
- b) The Organiser is not responsible for any injury, loss or damage that the Competitor, or any related party of the Competitor, may suffer by entering and or competing in the Competition.
- c) The Competitor acknowledges that the Organiser has the right to expel a Competitor from the Competition.
- d) The Competitor acknowledges and agrees to comply with these Rules. The Competitor acknowledges that any failure to comply with these Rules may result in their disqualification of the Competition and the requirement to return any cash, prizes or giveaways that they have received from the Organiser.

- e) The Competitor acknowledges that the Organiser may change any Rules at anytime at their absolute discretion and all decisions made by the Organiser are final.
- f) Any issues that are not included in these Rules and Regulations will be determined by the Organiser separately and the Organiser's decision is final.
- g) The Competitor must complete and agree to any other documentation that the Organiser may require the Competitor to agree to including amongst others, any separate Waiver of Liability or Image Releases. If the Competitor does not agree and comply with any such other documents, the Organiser may disqualify the Competitor from the Competition.

10. Film & Photography

- a) All film and photography is the property of the Organiser. The Competitor has no rights to the film and or photography and is not entitled to any payment in relation to the film and photography in any way whatsoever.
- b) The Competitor irrevocably agrees the Organiser may use any film and photography for any purposes whatsoever.
- c) All filming and photography at the Competition must be pre-approved by the Organiser and the Competitor must not release any unauthorised film or photography on any social media or electronic platform whatsoever.

11. Props and Costume

- a) Props, including human props, are permitted but must be pre approved by the Organiser.
- b) The Competitor is responsible for any damage caused to or by their props in any way whatsoever.
- c) The Competitor must purchase a ticket for each human prop.
- d) Partial or full nudity is not permitted. A who fails to comply with this rule will be immediately disqualified from the Competition.

12. Judging

- a) Judges decisions are final and are not open to appeal.
- b) Competitors must not communicate with the judging panel before or during the Competition.
- c) All competitors will be judged in accordance with the following criteria:

Pole Tricks = 20 points (flexibility = 5; strength = 5; power = 5; execution = 5)

Dance = 10 points

Presentation & Costume = 10 points

Narrative & Showmanship = 10 points
